<u>Medical Treatment:</u> Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge Habitat and Partners from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with Habitat and Partners.

<u>Assumption of the Risk</u>: The Volunteer understands that the Activities include work that may be hazardous to the Volunteer, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from the work sites.

Volunteer hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in the Activities and releases Habitat and Partners from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from the Activities.

<u>Insurance:</u> The Volunteer understands that, except as otherwise agreed to in writing; Habitat and Partners do not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer.

Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.
